### **About IDA**

IDA is a governmental economic authority responsible for executing industrial policies set by the Ministry of Trade and Industry and its affiliated bodies, to stimulate and encourage investment in the industrial sector.

IDA is in charge of setting and implementing land development policies for industrial purposes, providing investors with land and facilitating procedures for obtaining industrial licenses.

### **Vision**

Promoting Industry in Egypt to be one of the leading Industrial countries in the MENA Region through: enhancing local manufacturing, expanding the Industries of high value added and high tech components, and creating an attractive business environment for both Arab and foreign investment.

- 2. Environment protection services.
- 3.Identifying the annual needs of Hazardous chemicals substances for other competents authorities (Civil Protection General Security Central Administration for Pharmaceutical Affairs).
- 4.Letters of testimony to industrial companies importing waste authorized to be imported and not on the lists of waste prohibited, as a production requirement

for these companies (e.g. plastic residues - paper ... etc.).

- 5.Receiving, reviewing and evaluating environmental supply studies for low-risk industrial activities (notification licensee system) and issuing environmental approvals.
- 6. Receiving, reviewing and evaluating environmental supply studies for highrisk industrial activities (pre licensing system).
- 7.Reconciliation of the conditions for high risk industrial companies established and operated before the Environmental Law.



# Brief on Law No. 15 of 2017 of facilitating the procedures for granting licenses for industrial establishments and its executive regulations No. 1082 of 2017

- The law and its executive regulations represent a quantum leap in the history of the Egyptian industry for the following reasons:
- Regulating the issuance of industrial licenses according to the degree of risks arising from practicing industrial activities. The law is specifically concerned with safety, environment, health and security.
- Overcoming all obstacles facing industrial development in Egypt through:
  - 1. Unifying the competent administrative authority dealing with investors to be IDA instead of a large number of agencies.
  - 2. Reducing the procedures for obtaining licenses to take one month at most instead of two years.
  - 3. Facilitating the requirements for obtaining licenses to be in accordance with the best international practices and standards.
  - 4. Activating decentralization by providing various services in IDA's branches, such as obtaining licenses.
  - Speeding up procedures by their automation so that the investor can obtain all licensing services through IDA's electronic portal.



- Industrial licenses are issued for an indefinite period, and obtaining licenses is either through the notification licensing system for low-risk establishments, or the prior licensing system for high-risk establishments.
- In the notification licensing system, the investor notifies IDA that he has fulfilled all the conditions required to carry out his industrial activity. Accordingly, IDA issues the license within a period not exceeding one week. The investor has the right to start his activity as soon as he notifies IDA. IDA is obligated to inspect the establishment within a period not exceeding ninety days.
- While in the prior licensing system, the investor applies to obtain the license based on fulfilling all the requirements required to practice his activity, and IDA inspects the establishment within thirty days from the date of application and issues this license based on the inspection.
- The law and its regulations also provide the investor with the opportunity to seek the assistance of the accreditation offices registered at IDA to ensure that the requirements and documents necessary for obtaining licenses are met.
- The law provides special facilities for small and micro enterprises.
- The law regulates the work of grievance committees, each headed by a deputy of the President of the State Council, to consider grievances related to licenses and accreditation offices.

## About IDA Law no.95 of 2018 And Its Executive Regulations no.198 of 2021

The law stated that IDA is the responsible authority for regulating industrial activities in Egypt, managing its affairs, implementing industrial policies developed by the Ministry of Trade and Industry and its subsidiaries, setting and implementing land development policies for industrial purposes and making them available to investors, and Facilitating the issuance of industrial licenses.

Accordingly, IDA main role is to:

- 1. Review industrial legislations and develop required amendments and policies.
- 2. Develop studies and strategies for industrial development whether at a sectorial or geographical level. Additionally, follow-up and encourage their implementation.
- Issue policies and strategies for the development of industrial zones, also undertakes necessary methodology for their development whether direct development or through licenses, development contracts or development contracts with the private sector.



- 4. Identify industrial activities and products, as well as associated service activities that are carried out in industrial zones in coordination with the Environmental Affairs Authority, the governorates, other governmental entities, and private sector entities, as well as the identification of industrial activities that are prohibited or those that may be engaged only on special terms.
- IDA has established branches and offices all over Egypt, each with a sufficient number of qualified staff in different specializations.
- 6. IDA coordinates with the General Authority for Investment and Free Zones (GAFI) to ensure integrating the industrial map with the investment map and the absence of any conflict between them while presenting industrial investment opportunities to investors, and constantly following up on any update on the two maps whether by automation or by regular update every six months.



# Industrial Zones Support, Facilitation and Development Fund

Both the Presidential decree no.350 of 2005 and Law no. 95 of 2018 emphasize the role of IDA in promoting and encouraging investments in the industrial sector, not only that but also emphasize IDA's role in amplifying, implementing and developing policies for industrial purposes.

In light of the above, IDA has established a fund to support, embed infrastructure and develop industrial zones under the above-mentioned laws, with main mission to support land prices and service activities in the zone, which leads to enhancing the industrial zone ability to attract investments and achieve the vision of IDA in attaining comprehensive and sustainable industrial development in Egypt.

According to Article 16 of Law no. 95 of 2018, the fund role was articulated as follows:

First: embedding the infrastructure of the industrial zones (sewage, water, roads, electricity, natural gas... Etc.).

Second: supporting land prices, industrial production, and service activities in industrial zones.

Third: Supporting the policies that encourage industry in order to attract investments and to encourage the competitiveness of industrial zones.

The Fund has an independent legal personality, and its Board of Directors is formed pursuant to a decree issued by the Minister of Trade and industry as follows:

- IDA Chairman (President)
- Two Vice-Chairmen
- Representative of the Council of State
- Representative of the Ministry of Trade and Industry
- Representative of the Ministry of Finance
- Representative of the Ministry of Local Development
- Number of experts



### **IDA Partners**

### 1. Industrial Development Company (IDC)

- Industrial Development Company (IDC)was established in 2017 with the aim of being the executive arm of IDA for managing and developing industrial zones.
- Operations management (security and guarding waste disposal - maintenance of green spaces) and infrastructure maintenance of industrial zones or complexes.
- Providing various services in each industrial zone/complex (logistics production development training marketing).

### 2. Accreditation offices

Accreditation offices are for reviewing and evaluating the requirements collected in establishments licenses (published on IDA's website).


### 3. Industrial developers
